





## **Foundations of Ocean Governance**






Regional Maritime Boundaries in 2001

9 out of 48 shared boundaries under treaty (blue lines)

#### **STATUS UPDATE**

#### **Boundaries:**

- 36 out of 48 shared boundaries are under treaty
- 8 treaties remain to be brought into force (yellow)
- 12 shared boundaries remain to be signed (pink)
- 5 countries high seas limits have yet to be declared (white)

#### **Extended Continental Shelf:**

- 9 PICT submissions in the queue
- 2 have received recommendations
- 2 in review
- 5 are partial submissions
- Another 6 are preliminary info notes, requiring more data

National leads with political connections have been vital




